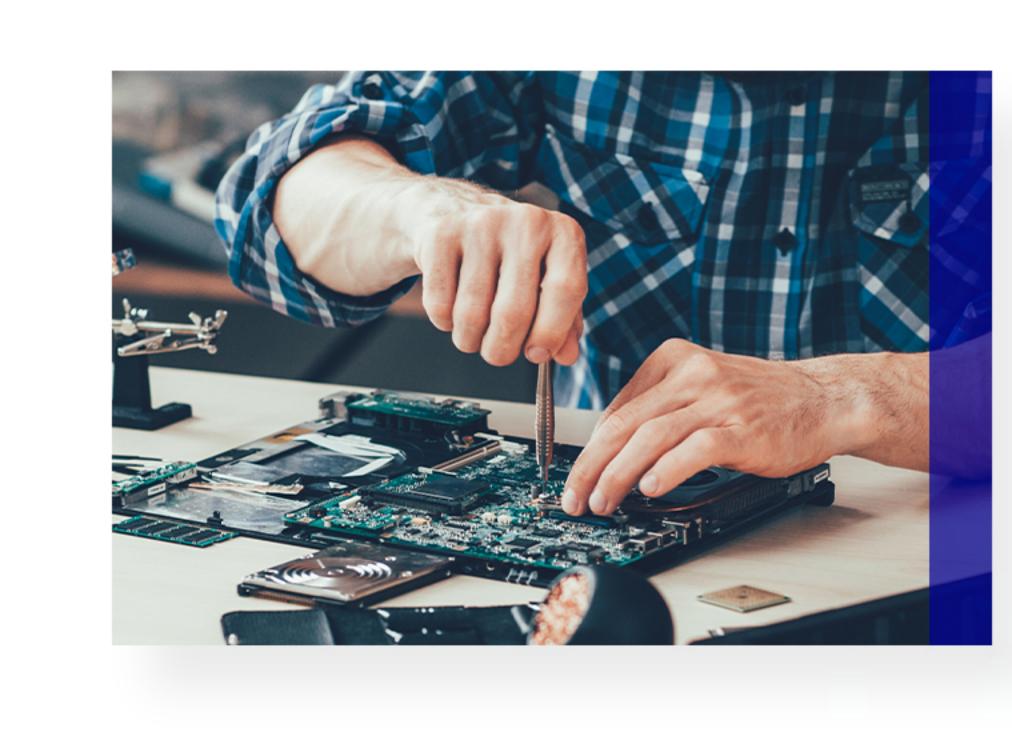


Purpose of a Server Maintenance Plan

Assesses system security

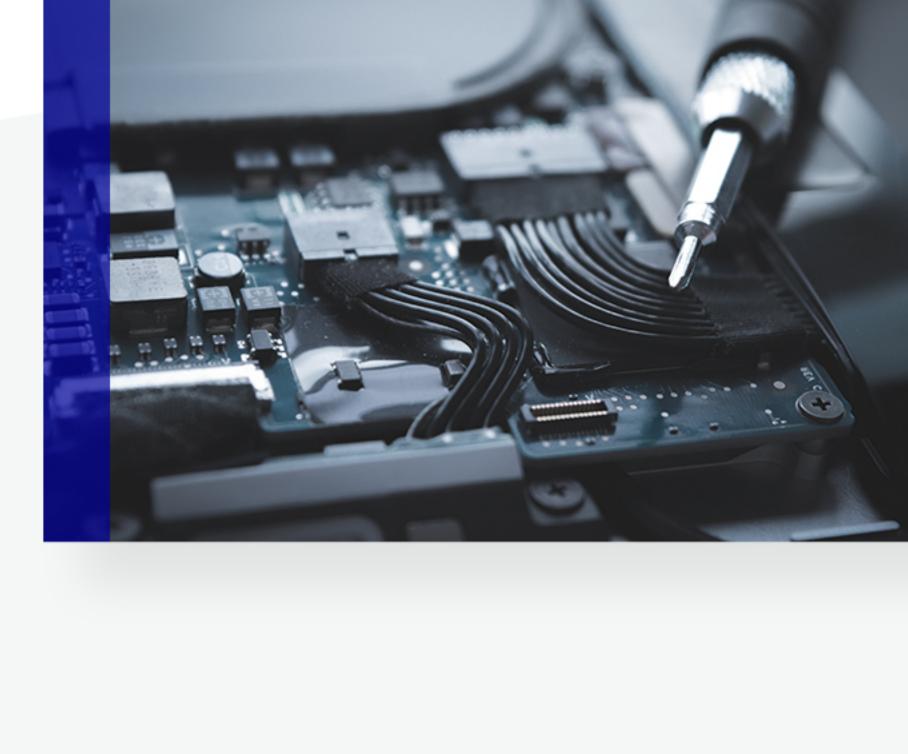

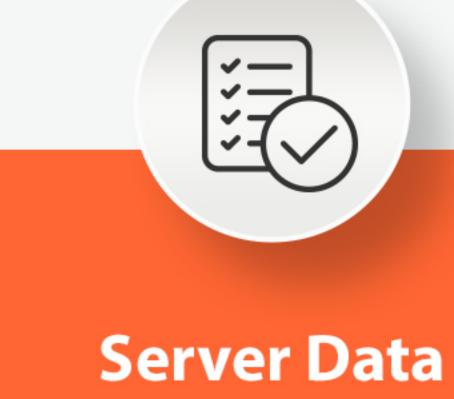
